To promote team building skills, character education and resilience through physical activity	Hold weekly Commando Joe sessions for Y2 to Y6, focussing on active outdoor learning including after school session.	Autumn 2018 to summer 2019	£11,000
To build on previous developments in teacher expertise and confidence in teaching gymnastics	External provider to lead KS1&2 gymnastics sessions with the class teacher	Spring term 2019	£70 x 12 sessions = £840
To support practitioner expertise in promoting the physical development of pupils in Foundation Stage	External provider to work with staff in F1, F2 and Y1 to develop their provision in outdoor play, gross motor skills, PSED and physical, sporting activity.	September to August 2019	£67.50 per session = £2633
To provide additional after school coaching in gymnastics for pupils showing particular interest or talent or for those who have been physically inactive	External provider to deliver after school gymnastics session	Spring and summer 2019	£31.50 x 12 sessions = £387
To support transport to and from swimming sessions for pupils in Y4 to Y6	External provider to provide weekly safe transport to swimming venue.	September to December 2018	£2208
To support the school in delivering quality PE and taking part in local sports events and competitions	Ashfield School Sports Partnership contribution and Netball Association fees	For the academic year 2018 - 19	£750 + £40 = £1150
To provide a 12 week Change4Life course for targeted year groups (Y3)	External provider to lead groups through the Active Ashfield Change4Life programme promoting healthy and active lifestyles	Spring term 2019	£300
To enable more pupils to take part in local sports events	School to arrange transport to and from local sports events to increase participation	Throughout the year as required	£500
To resurface the existing KS2 playground to make it fit for purpose for sports activities. Improvements are to include marking out the surface for a variety of team games and a perimeter track to support the 30 minutes daily physical activity.	Pupils will have access to a quality outdoor surface to support the delivery of curriculum and after school team games and the provision of the 30 minutes daily physical activity	Spring term 2019	Approximately £8000
